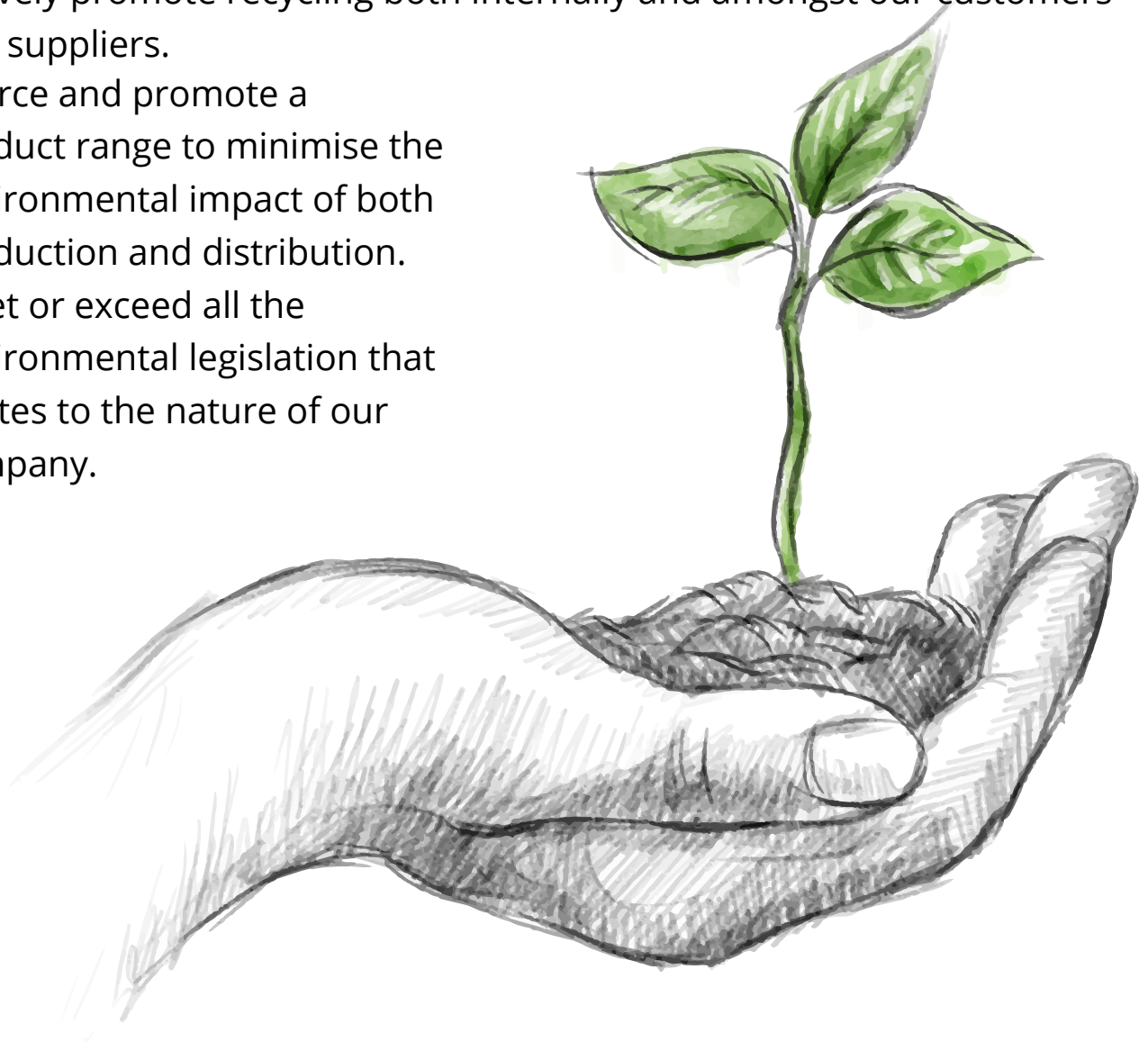

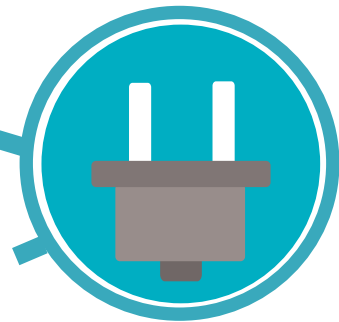

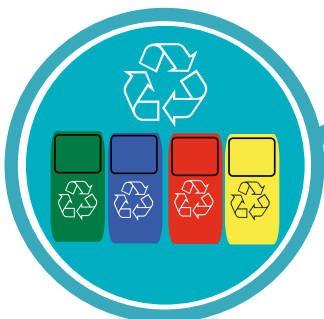

Paper

All of the paper we use is FSC certified and is manufactured from pulp sourced sustainable stocks. FSC is an independent, non-governmental, not-for-profit organisation established to promote the responsible management of the world's forests.

FSC certification provides a credible link between responsible production and consumption of forest products, enabling consumers and businesses to make purchasing decisions that benefit people and the environment as well as providing ongoing business value.



Chemistry Free Plates

Printing plates are used to transfer an image to paper or other substances. Ink is applied to the plate's image area and transferred directly to the paper. Typically this was achieved using photochemical processes. Priory Press Packaging have adopted the Azura V System for plate-making. The elimination of the developer means that one of the main variables affecting image consistency disappears. This transition has also resulted in the following key benefits:

- 1.** Greatly reduced chemistry consumption (about a third of the usage compared to standard CTP plates – representing 100 litres per month).
- 2.** Greatly reduced waste disposal costs.
- 3.** Greatly reduced water consumption; no pre-wash required.
- 4.** Quicker ink and water balance achieved on press reducing paper usage during start up.
- 5.** The Azura V plate is washed out using nothing more than gum, making it more environmentally friendly.
- 6.** A cost saving on the cost of running the saving compared to chemical processes.

All printing plates are also recycled after use.



Inks & Sealants

Natural Soya - based inks

At Priory Press Packaging, we use natural Soya-based inks. As opposed to traditional petroleum-based ink, vegetable-based inks are more environmentally friendly, may provide more accurate colours, and make it easier to recycle paper.

All of our sealers are water-based (products are sealed to encapsulate the inks, making them less susceptible to 'rubbing off'. Water-based sealers are used instead of solvent-based products because they create a cleaner, safer environment for employees and customers; maintaining environmental air quality and reducing harmful fumes. Thanks to improving technology, many water-based sealants now outperform their solvent based counterparts.



Energy Resources

All of the energy used to power our machinery comes from renewable sources, namely wind power. Wind power consumes no fuel and emits no air pollution, unlike fossil fuel power sources.

Our energy provider Go Power represents a cost saving to Priory Press Packaging compared to fossil fuel based power. Through the Carbon Trust, we have installed low LED lighting on our whole production floor which are more energy efficient and less harmful to the environment.



Waste Management

We operate an internal waste recycling plan which has reduced our waste disposal costs significantly.

All dry goods including paper, plastics, metal, cartons and laminated print are recycled.

We have all reusable pallets collected to be reused again.

We also recycle office ink cartridges through The Recycling Factory who ensure the cartridges are recycled or disposed of in an ethical and environmentally friendly way.



Cycle to Work Scheme

At Priory Press Packaging, we operate the Northern Ireland Department of Transport's Cycle To Work Scheme. The initiative encourages employees to cycle to work reducing air pollution from cars, whilst also encouraging a healthy lifestyle. The incentive allows employees to obtain bicycles tax-free.



Uniform Recycling

We operate a 'new for old' uniform recycling policy, whereby employees can return their old uniform which we then recycle, in exchange for a new uniform.

THE CONTROLLED WASTE (REGISTRATION OF CARRIERS AND SEIZURE OF VEHICLES) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1999 (as amended)

I refer to your application to register as a Lower Tier Carrier, which has now been approved by the Northern Ireland Environment Agency.

You are now registered under the above legislation and your unique registration number is **ROC LT00466**.

Please note that under Article 42 (3) any person engaged in transporting waste may be asked to produce evidence of registration by an authorised officer of the Department or a Police officer. Therefore, I would advise that vehicles involved in the transport of waste should carry evidence of authority to do so, in the form of this letter.

Transport of controlled waste without holding a valid registration is a criminal offence and involves a maximum fine of £5,000.
